

WARRANTY STATEMENT

Your satisfaction is essential to Weiland. We warrant the original owner of our products and components the following:

- **5-year guarantee:** against failure due to workmanship and materials on door panels and frames

WORKMANSHIP:

Weiland, Inc. guarantees against failure due to materials and workmanship, including warp, separation or delamination, and expansion of the door panel for five years. Certain exceptions apply. See below for details.

FRAMES & CASINGS:

Steel, by its nature, has minor scratches and blemishes. Weiland, Inc. tries hard to use the best cuts of steel to make frames and casings. Frames and casings are to be free of significant defects when leaving the factory. Weiland, Inc. is not liable for gouges, wrinkles, or other aesthetic blemishes that occur during installation or operation.

HARDWARE:

Weiland, Inc. hardware is warranted to be free of defects in both workmanship and materials for one year. This does not include items that may require minor adjustments in the field to function as needed. The Purchaser must return the defective goods to Weiland, Inc. with freight charges paid by the Purchaser. Hardware manufactured by others but supplied by Weiland, Inc. is covered separately according to the hardware manufacturer's guarantees.

LIMITED WARRANTY:

Weiland Inc. does not include Labor and expenses incurred to remove or replace any defective product or component thereof as part of their warranty. This warranty is null and void if the product has been altered (including non-standard installation) in any way without the advanced written consent of Weiland, Inc.

LIMITED LIABILITY:

Weiland, Inc.'s liability is, under all circumstances, be limited to repair, replacement, or refund of your original purchase price of the defective door or material. Weiland, Inc. is not liable for incidental or consequential damages, claims, or losses. Weiland, Inc.'s liability on any claim or loss shall in no case exceed the price paid by Purchaser for the items.

EXCEPTIONS and CONDITIONS:

1. Damage caused by misuse or mishandling during installation and operation
2. Natural variations in the sheen, texture, or color degradation of the doors.
3. Variations such as temperature, humidity, wind speed, and barometric pressure on opposite sides of the door are typical in many FRP door applications. These variations may cause minor bowing and warp in FRP doors. For doors 3'x7' or smaller, warp not exceeding one-fourth inch (1/4") in the plane of the door itself. Doors up to 5'x10', warp not exceeding three-eighths inch (3/8") in the plane of the door itself. For FRP doors larger than 5' 0" x 10' 0" warp shall not exceed 5/8".
4. Brake lines on frames and casings when mill-finished. They may require light scrubbing to get additional metal shavings off the brake lines.
5. Caulk joints. They may come undone if high-pressure water is sprayed directly on them.
6. Corrosion from frames and casings left in standing water.
7. Improper fit due to poor installation and opening preparations.
